- Daily change of socks and underwear (x7)
- Swimsuit
- Shorts/jeans (x4)
- Shoes (tennis & hiking)
- NO OPEN TOED SHOES ALLOWED.**
- Towels (x2)
- Toiletry articles
- Rain gear
- Scout Handbook
- Blankets & sheets / Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Foot Locker / Plastic Tub (for personal storage)
- Paper / Pencil / Pen / Notebook
- Merit badge pamphlets & material
- Flashlight / Headlamp
- Batteries
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellant
- Duct Tape
- Twine / Rope
- Compass\*
- Canteen / Water bottle\***
- Backpack\*
- Ground cloth / Tarp\*+
- Money for program materials  
(baskets, leather, rocket kits)
- Money for trading post (**bills smaller than \$5 are preferable!**)
- OA Sash
- Work Gloves
- \* Needed for Wilderness Survival and Camping Merit Badges

- American Flag
- State Flag

- Fire Extinguisher (must be current ABC)
- Dining Fly / Tarps
- Duct Tape
- Any other items that will help the troop during their stay.
